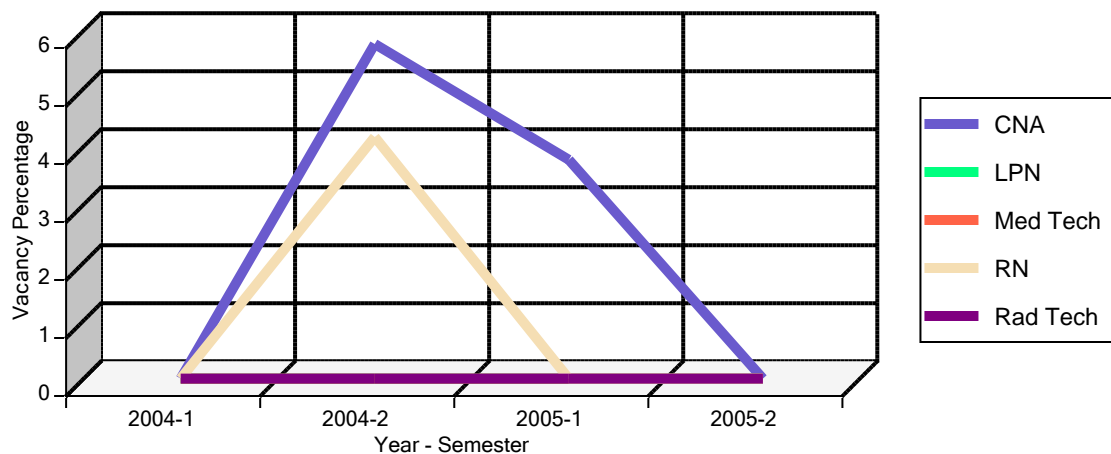

Semi Annual Staff Vacancy Report for Hospital A



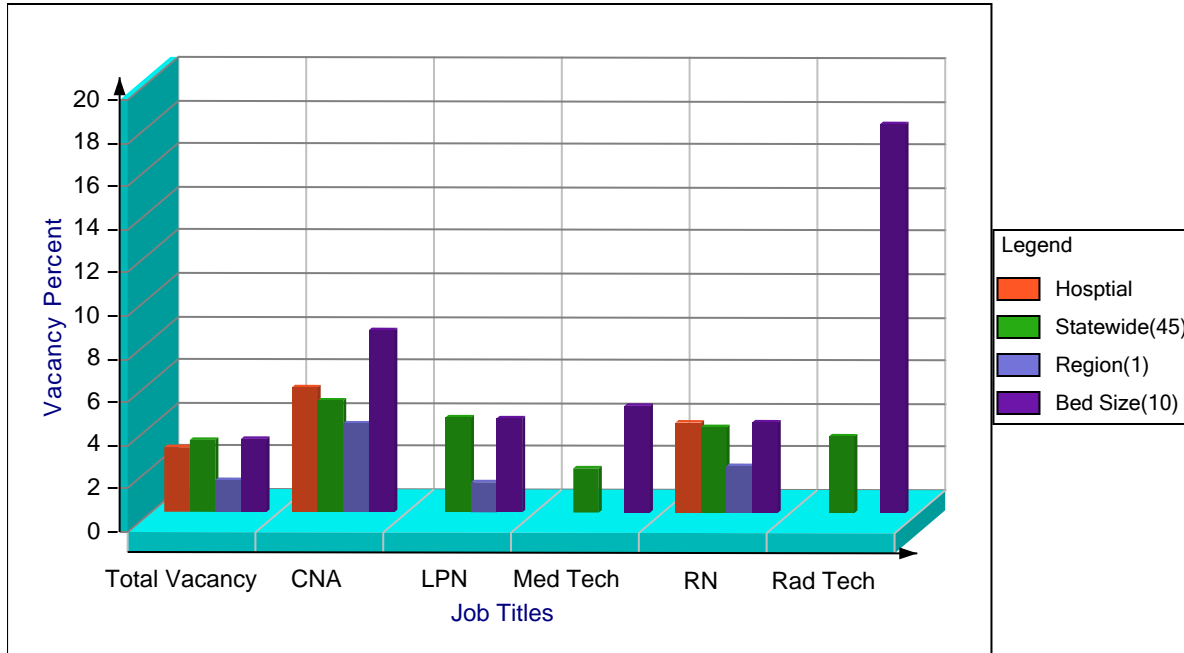
This graph shows trending information for your hospital. You can compare your own data to see if the percentage of vacant positions has increased or decreased.
