Hospitals and Health Systems that excel across national patient safety and quality measurements invariably describe strong leaders and a culture that expects and wholeheartedly supports excellence in patient safety, quality and patient experience. The Minnesota Hospital Association along with several successful mentor hospitals are collaborating to guide a cohort of hospitals and health systems on a journey to a culture of excellence.

The critical role of leadership in building a successful culture underlies the expectation that participating hospital/health system CEOs actively participate in the design, implementation, and support phases of the cohort.
